Activity to develop language skills Word hunt

- Let's pick up a newspaper.

Homemade Bubble Fun

- Blowing bubbles is absolutely magical.
- Child is always captivated by the whimsical charm of different sized rainbow- tinted bubbles floating through the air.
- All you need to start with an easy homemade bubble solution.
- Take water, liquid detergent, container, whisk, straw.
- 2 caps of liquid detergent.
- 6 cups of water.
- 1 TBSP glycerin.
- You can use it immediately, but the bubble solution improves if you let it sit overnight.
- Use your solution for fantastic bubble making fun.
- Blow bubbles on a paper and observe the impressions.
- Take any old printed photo of any family member and turn it into a photo frame.
- Once you are back we will have a show and tell activity.
